# **Green Acres**

Houston takes its parks seriously. With more than 350 parks and 200+ green spaces, Houston is ranked <u>first in the nation</u> for total green space among comparable cities. ## We Major

Houston has five professional major league teams: the Houston Astros (MLB), Houston Texans (NFL), Houston Rockets (NBA), Houston Dynamo FC (MLS), and Houston Dash (NWSL). # **Northside Neighborhoods**

Jersey Village is close to campus and about 20 miles from downtown Houston. Here, you will get your fill of golf, swimming pools, and parks, and even enjoy fishing in Jersey Village's small lake! <u>Carverdale</u> neighborhood offers a nice mix of housing options and things to do in your off-time.

If you have kids to consider in this move, Houston has a number of terrific school districts to choose from, and most are located Northside. Conroe Independent School District is ranked among the top ISDs in the city. Conroe received an "A" rating from <u>Niche.com</u> and is made up of 62 different schools. There are also a variety of private school options that serve students from preschool to K12.

### **A Few Logistics**

#### **Interactive Maps**

Getting the lay of the land is easy with this collection of interactive maps.

#### **Airports**

There are two major airports to choose from if flying to Houston. George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH) is the primary airport and is located 23 miles north of downtown Houston. You can also use the William P. Hobby Airport (HOU) located seven miles south of downtown.

#### **Cost of Living**

According to Payscale.com, the cost of living in Houston is -8% less than the national average. Use their handy <u>calculator</u> to compare to where you live now!

#### **Expected Housing Cost**

You should expect to pay around \$1,200 for a studio or 1-bedroom apartment. Rents are on the decline by around -9% in Houston, according to Zumper.com.

#### **Housing Questions to Ask**

- How long is the lease, and is the lease length flexible?
- What utilities (such as heating and cable) are covered in the lease?
- Is there laundry in the building?

#### **Parking Considerations**

Be sure to ask the property manager whether there is parking onsite/how much it costs, whether street parking is by permit only, and how difficult street parking is.
