

Accelerated Transfer BSN

TLU's Accelerated Transfer BSN program is a 16-month, campus-based program that leads to a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree. This program is only offered at the Houston campus, where you will receive a curriculum that enables you to take the nursing licensure exam.

Admission Qualifications

- Have earned 64 credits from a regionally accredited institution with a GPA of 3.0 or better.
- Have earned a GPA of 3.0 or greater in the Nursing prerequisites (highlighted courses below)
- Have earned a TEAS composite score of 70 or higher, taken within a year of the start month (i.e. January, June, September).
- Provide a recommender who completes an evaluation through NursingCAS. A letter of recommendation to accompany the evaluation form is encouraged.
- Complete the two essays included within the application for admission through NursingCAS.
- Complete pre-required coursework.
